

# Reverse Fingerprint Christmas Tree Cards

This art activity is great for kids of all ages - it will keep them busy, and you get a keepsake for friends and family.

It's fun to watch the shape of the tree form as you peel off the shape.

## What you'll need

- Blank cards
- Paint
- Cookie cutter
- Tape

- 1. Print out a small Christmas tree shape or trace a tree cookie cutter with pencil on cardstock and cut out
- 2. Attach tape to the back of the tree shape so that the sticky side is to the back
- 3. Attach the tree shape to the front of the card
- 4. Let your kids paint the card with paint and their finger prints
- 5. Let the cards dry
- 6. Peel off the tree shapes from the card and stick to another card
