

# Reverse Fingerprint Christmas Tree Cards

This art activity is great for kids of all ages - it will keep them busy, and you get a keepsake for friends and family.

It's fun to watch the shape of the tree form as you peel off the shape.

## What you'll need

- Blank cards
- Paint
- Cookie cutter
- Tape

## Steps

1. Print out a small Christmas tree shape or trace a tree cookie cutter with pencil on cardstock and cut out
2. Attach tape to the back of the tree shape so that the sticky side is to the back
3. Attach the tree shape to the front of the card
4. Let your kids paint the card with paint and their finger prints
5. Let the cards dry
6. Peel off the tree shapes from the card and stick to another card
